Noeline Dransfield was a well known local horsewoman and farmer who skilfully drove her homebred horses to the gig and phaeton displayed here. Noeline, who hunted with the Manawatu Hunt for many years, bred some well known hunters and show jumpers. Notably among these were 'Socks' and 'Oliver Twist'. Her great pride and delight in later years was 'Dancer', bred to be a hunter from a pure clydesdale mare, who also excelled in dressage, show jumping, eventing and won her ribbons at the Manawatu Royal Show in the gig for driving. Many local brides will have photos of this striking black horse with the blaze pulling them in the phaeton in all their weddibng finery. As the young Noeline Bolton of 'Oete' Wairarapa, she was very successful in the 1940's riding her big horse 'Kopane' to win the fast 'Round the Ring' jumping competitions so popular at A and P Shows and country sports meetings in those days. Well known horsewoman Freda White was rival. Horses and riders would ride long distances or travel by train, compete all day, taking part in mounted games too, party all night and return home again by train or on horseback. Noeline delighted in giving pleasure by driving her immaculate horsedrawn antique vehicles in the centenary Parades for all the country primary schools, annual Palmerston North Christmas Parades and Cancer Society collecting, the Nga Tawa School Jubilee and for visits to rest homes and weddings.	29/06/2017	7
